Amber has been sharing information, altered images, and implied calls to harass myself and my family in multiple posts each day on her public profiles. I believe that if nothing is done, she will continue to stalk and harass us incessantly to no end. I have asked her to stop in a civil manner but she harbors an unhealthy obsession. I have been successful in getting Instagram to remove two of her profiles for bullying but she continues to create new ones.

ATTACHMENT 7a(3)

Amber Easley received an altered screenshot of a domestic violence incident from Trisha Keeling, another cyberbully we have a restraining order in the process of being filed for harassment. The incident occurred on May 16th 2023 naming me as the victim and my [REDACTED] as the assailant. This case was dismissed by the San Bernardino County District Attorney on January 24, 2024 as it was revealed that the incident was initiated by an autistic meltdown caused by sensory overload-no physical contact was made by [REDACTED]. This is official court record.

Amber, knowing that the information was altered to omit the dismissal, either did not check the validity of the information, or moved forward to harass anyway, fully aware of the incident as Trisha was informed on October 18th by myself that the information was not complete and involved my private medical emergency, along with a family trauma. Amber and Trisha are best friends and have made it a hobby to harass Redlands residents with mistruths and/or private information using public bully pages in an attempt to discredit and incite community harassment of these residents.

On October 18th, 2024, Amber used her public Instagram bully page of over 8,000 members, "eyerollsandbloodlust" to post her first shot at harassment of [REDACTED] (see attached screenshots), over being jilted that her and her best friend Trisha were removed as followers from community Facebook news groups over violations of community standards and the group rules. The post had pictures of [REDACTED] along with a graphic added reading "Some of you men have never been told to shut the (expletive) up and it shows", along with a typed narrative using more abusive language toward him. I reported the post and the page to Instagram citing bullying and harassment. The platform agreed and removed the entire page permanently on October 19th, 2024. She then went to a public backup page she had, "eyerollsandbloodlust2.0" that quickly amassed over 900 followers as she posted promises of juicy gossip over someone who was "big mad" and got her page taken down. On October 23rd, 2024, she shot her shot, and posted in this public forum that [REDACTED], along with his picture (see attached screenshots) I commented immediately that she was incorrect, that the arrest was false, and that by posting this information under the guise that she believed that I was abused in this way, she was in violation of my rights and privacy as a victim. I also pointed out that the false arrest was as a result of an autistic episode of mine, and leaving the post up now that she was on notice would also constitute ableism and harassment of myself. I immediately took screenshots of the post and my retort (see attached pictures), and reported the post and page to Instagram. She hid my comments and kept the post live, despite having knowledge of my story. For hours, followers on the page took jabs in the comment section at myself, my disability (for those that saw my comment), my age, the appearance of myself and

[REDACTED] etc. On October 24th, 2024 Instagram agreed again that the second page was engaging in harassment and removed that one permanently as well. She has since gone to X (formally Twitter) to continue the harassment.

Hello. I am not a battered wife. Many of your followers know who I am. There is a statute known as the violence against women act where if in fact I was a victim of domestic violence, this post would be victimizing me as well. If you really knew how to look things up, you would have discovered that this was dismissed. I am autistic and had a medical emergency as a result of an autistic meltdown, but the police misconstrued what was going on. Your little friend that fed you this information knows this, which means you know this, so you are not only an abelist hag, but an abuser of women's rights on top of it. The real story folks, is that these bullies were warned multiple times in the groups they participated in to stop violating community standards or they would be kicked out. They would not stop, and they were kicked out. Now their little egos are bruised and they have nothing better to do than victimize people. @denisedavisforredlands @belchingbabe why are you even supporting these horrid people? What kind of example do any of you wish to set for the community?
