

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts A REFERENDUM PETITION

Pursuant to Article XLVIII of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth

"We protest against chapter 216 of the Acts of 2008", "An Act Relative to Certain Marriage Laws." We request a referendum on this law.

FILING DEADLINES. Referendum petitions must be submitted to local election officials for certification of signatures no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, October 15, 2008. Local election officials must complete their certification no later than October 27, 2008. Thereafter, referendum petitions containing certified signatures must be retrieved by petitioners from the local election officials and then filed with the Elections Division, Office of the Secretary of the Commonwealth, One Ashburton Place, Room 1705, Boston, MA, no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, October 29, 2008.

SUMMARY

This law eliminates restrictions against persons from other states getting married in Massachusetts on the same terms as Massachusetts residents.

The law eliminates the prohibition against a person getting married in Massachusetts if the marriage would be void if performed in the person's home state. Under the law, such a person's marriage is no longer void in Massachusetts

if performed here, and it is no longer a crime to knowingly issue a license for, or to perform, such a marriage in this state.

The law also eliminates the requirement that a city or town clerk, before issuing a marriage license to a person from another state, verify that the marriage would not be prohibited from being performed in the person's home state.
