Dear Mr. Parker:

It has come to my attention that you refused to leave the Estabrook School today after meeting with school officials, including the Principal and Director of Instruction for Lexington Public Schools. When efforts by these administrators to have you leave the school failed after frequent urgings they informed you that if you continued to refuse to leave, you would be considered trespassing and they would be compelled to notify the Lexington Police. After numerous requests to leave from the Principal, Director, and Lexington Police over a period of more than two hours, you were placed under arrest for trespassing.

As a result consider this a Trespass Notice for all Lexington Public Schools' grounds and facilities. At no time should you be on Lexington Public Schools' properties. If you are found on Lexington Public Schools' properties you will be subject to arrest by the Lexington Police. Access to school properties can only be accomplished with prior written authorization from the Superintendent of Schools or his designee.
